Launch of Unique Quantum Computer at Forschungszentrum Jülich

Dear Sir or Madam, Dear Colleagues,

In a few days, Forschungszentrum Jülich and D-Wave Systems will launch the first quantum computing system with more than 5000 qubits outside of North America. This will make Jülich the first site in Europe to operate the latest-generation system of the Canadian manufacturer: an Advantage quantum annealer. The D-Wave system, which will be operated at the Jülich Supercomputing Centre (JSC), will be the first quantum computer worldwide to be operated in direct combination with a supercomputer. The new quantum annealer will be part of the Jülich UNified Infrastructure for Quantum computing (JUNIQ), which was established in 2019 to provide users from science and industry in Germany and Europe with access to various quantum systems.
